

Job Placement Survey of Class 2023

The Department of Library and Information Science at the Catholic University of America conducted a job placement survey of the 24 graduates who graduated in Spring 2023, Summer 2023, and Fall 2023. Three (12.5%) of the 24 graduates invited to participate took part in the survey. The following data are valuable for the department to learn the career development of graduates.

Major findings:

- 66.7% of respondents were employed full-time.
- 100% of respondents were employed in a library or information setting while completing the program.
- 66.7% of respondents were in a permanent employment position.
- 90.9% were employed in a Library or Information Science Institution, such as public library, federal library, and archives or special collections.
- Most common job assignments the respondents were responsible for were reference/information services (100%), digitization (66.7%), metadata, cataloging & taxonomy (66.7%), etc.
- A portion of respondents were able to elevate their position from support staff to professional staff upon granting of the MSLIS degree.
- The average annual salary was \$55,000.
